What is Starkick?

Starkick is an All Abilities football program for boys and girls aged between 5 and 18. Founded and launched by the Coolbinia Bombers JFC in 2015, the program promotes inclusion, equality and opportunity and will be running as an integral part of our Clubs Auskick Centre this year and beyond.

Starkick caters for children who by circumstance or choice, are unable to join into a clubs existing Football program. Children who may need extra support or time to achieve their goals are supported by a team of volunteers, coaches and parents. Starkick aims to cater for all disabilities and runs by a simple mantra – "If you want to play we will find a way", I personally feel very blessed that we are able to bring this very important program to this area.

Benefits to children:

- Engage in games and activities geared towards their own abilities.
- Inclusion and equality A sense of belonging and being part of a wider team and club.
- Learn the basics of teamwork and build social skills.
- Provided with the necessary support and when required have access to 1 on 1 assistance.
- Learn the basic principles and importance of physical activity. Generally children benefit from greater levels of confidence, self-awareness, improved health, fitness and overall well-being.
- Starkick aims to help children develop to their full potential but never forgetting the overall goal of having fun.

Benefits to parents:

- Opportunities for safe, quality family time that results in family bonding.
- A sense of belonging and community involvement with the opportunity to engage with children and other families.
- Greater social contact and interaction creating a framework for enhanced inclusion and acceptance for everyone.
